

## Small Group APPLICATION QUESTIONS

## SUMMARY

In our continuing *Just Give Me Jesus* series, Pastor Tim Millsaps walked us through John 12:12-26. His teaching titled "It's Not the Blind Who Can't See, It's the Unwilling" helped bring clarity to some of the reasons why people may choose to put their faith in Christ, while others do not. It also challenged believers to examine their reasons for faith.

- 1. Do not mistake man's display of outward appearances and actions as a true heart that has accepted Jesus as their Lord. (See also Isaiah 29:13)
  - What might it look like to honor God with your lips while your heart is far from Him?
  - What are some modern-day examples?
- 2. In verse 16 we read the disciples did not yet understand all the prophetical truth of Christ, but later the unrealized truth had made its way to their hearts.
  - What did it take for the disciples to understand?
  - What did it take for you to believe in Jesus? What aspects of salvation confused you

- in the past, or perhaps even now?
- Why do we tend to think we can convince others to understand?
- 3. Absolute truth is the only form of truth...everything else is opinion.
  - If God's Word is absolute truth, are there any areas of the Bible you currently struggle with believing to be true?
  - What steps are you taking to *truly* research and understand this struggle?
- 4. He meets those who come to sincerely worship and seek Him.
  - At what point in your life did you most seek the Lord? If it's NOT now, what changed? If it is now, can you share a recent revelation or insight He's given you?
- **PRAYER** That His Spirit continues to reveal and lead your heart to absolute truth.
