TALK IT OVER

1. Recognize there’s a battle you cannot see

- In the normal flow of life, how aware would you say you are that there is a spiritual battle happening?
- How might this greater awareness that there is a spiritual battle raging change the way you view life events and circumstances?

APPLICATION

2. Memorize Scripture

- Have someone read Ephesians 6:13-17. When it comes to spiritual warfare, what is our only weapon?
- Has scripture memorization ever been a part of your spiritual practices? Why or why not?
- Jay posed the question, “what is your main spiritual struggle?”, and challenged us to memorize a verse(s) to grow in that area. How can you take that challenge to heart and memorize scripture?

3. Pray Continually

- Have someone read Ephesians 6:18. What should be our attitude towards prayer?
- This week, what will it look like for you to move towards praying continually?
