READ IT TOGETHER

Mark 15:21-47

TALK IT OVER

1. Most are unaware they even have a need

Talk about how you personally realized that you had a need for Jesus. When did it happen and what brought you to that point?

2. Some simply misunderstand what Jesus said and who He is

What are some of the prevailing views today of what Jesus said and who He is? How can you be better prepared to give an answer to these misunderstandings (see 1 Peter 3:15)?

3. Some MUST earn their own way into heaven

Why is there a tendency for many people to feel like they must earn their own way to heaven, rather than accepting God's grace through Jesus? How can you help those in your life with these views to see truth?

4. We still question Jesus being the only way because we don't understand the price paid

We're told in verse 34 that Jesus, for the first time in history, was separated from the Father - an enormous price to pay for our sins. How should His costly sacrifice for us on the cross affect our lives in a practical way?

PRAYER

Pray that the reality of Jesus' sacrifice for us would bring us to a place of worship.
