

# Small Group APPLICATION QUESTIONS

"Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says." James 1:22 NIV

## SUMMARY

Pastor Tim taught a powerful message entitled "God in the Hands of Angry Sinners" in John 8:12-36, where he helped dissect the difference of those who are truly walking with Christ, those who aren't, and those who are simply missing the idea of who Jesus is altogether. The fruit of their lives, of course, are altogether different as well.

### 1. What's obvious to us can be easily missed by others.

- Who in your life is obviously missing out on all that Jesus has to offer? Why do you think that it's not obvious to them?
- At what point in time did you fully recognize you DESPERATELY needed Jesus in your life? Why do you think you didn't recognize this truth earlier in life?

### 2. Most people dismiss God's commands because they want their own way.

- Who in your life needs to hear this statement? How can you share this tactfully and lovingly with them?
- Share a time in your life when you knew truth, yet chose to satisfy your own desires. What guardrails do you have in your life now to keep you from making the same mistake(s) again?
- 3. Believing, accompanied by abiding, will lead to freedom. (When we walk in the light of Jesus, it is our ONLY chance to "go and sin no more.")
  - Why do we tend to think simply praying a prayer will give us freedom?
  - What does it mean to abide in Christ?
  - Can you honestly say you are involved in all of the things mentioned above?
  - What about your life would be so convincing that others would look on and know you are living a Christian life?
