SUMMARY

In Pastor Frank’s teaching “Something About His Wounds” from John 20:19-31, we previewed a few interactions that the risen Christ had with His disciples. The result of those conversations changed the entire history of the known world and provided the assurance the disciples needed to share the wondrous truths of God!

APPLICATION

1. In verse 19 we were given insight into the disciple’s fear, but Christ came with the truest message of peace. What ongoing situation has you in fear lately?
2. Before sending His disciples out He brought them not only peace but also confirmation of His resurrection (v.20-21). When you are trying to make a decision in life, what roles do peace and confirmation play in your decision-making?
3. Pastor Frank shared that the role and duty of the church is to warn against sin and speak the truth according to God’s Word. What can you do this week to speak truth into an area or relationship that you know is devoid of truth?
4. Jesus provided peace and proof of His resurrection to the group at large, but also to Thomas, an individual. How has the Lord spoken to you as an individual this week? More specifically, how has He spoken to you as you studied His Word?
5. We were challenged to take another look at what Christ did for us by thinking deeply about His wounds. Have someone read Isaiah 53:5 and discuss why Jesus endured these wounds. How can dwelling on His wounds lead you into a deeper relationship with Him this week?

PRAYER
