SUMMARY

This weekend Pastor Jay Everett shared about Renew, a ministry of Calvary Chapel Chattanooga. He pointed us to Matthew 28:19 and other various pieces of scripture that confirm the mission of the gospel: to raise up disciples.

APPLICATION

- 1. Renew is a 1-year, in-house discipleship ministry for those who have an evident desire to follow Christ, recognizing that the only way to live in freedom is with Him.**
 - Define the word ‘discipleship’.
 - Share what your discipleship journey (if any) has looked like so far.
Note: It’s okay if you haven’t yet received personal discipleship! You can answer the question: How can I pursue discipleship?
- 2. “You can’t outrun your heart.” Jay helped explain that a pattern of sin is not a disease, but rather a *worship disorder* of the heart.**
 - Why does culture want to write off sin patterns as a disease?
 - Review the passages Jay discussed in *Proverbs 14:12* & *Matthew 7:13-14*. Give an example of when you pawned off a decision of responsibility or blamed others for your choices. What was your motive behind it?
- 3. When sin enters back into the picture and breakdowns happen, Jay encourages folks to think back to a time when they were the healthiest and having victory.**
 - What was the healthiest season of your life spiritually? Why?
 - If today isn’t the healthiest season of your spiritual journey, what one step can you take this week to move in the right direction? Who in your life can help hold you accountable to making that step?
- 4. Find someone in your life to disciple.**
 - Is there someone the Lord has put on your heart to invest in and disciple? Do you think they feel the same way?
