## APPLICATION QUESTIONS

“Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.” James 1:22 NIV

### SUMMARY

Tyler Golson walked us through Exodus 19 with a message titled “Called Up”. From this passage, we learned about God’s authority and holiness, and the privilege it is to be called up by God into freedom and a relationship with Him.

### APPLICATION

#### 1. God is the ultimate authority

- Although the idea of “authority” tends to have a negative connotation in our culture today, talk about a few reasons why authority is so important?
- What part(s) of your life are not submitted to the authority of God? What needs to change?

#### 2. God is the most holy

- When you hear about the “holiness of God”, what comes into your mind?
- Tyler asked the question, “When was the last time that you praised God because He is holy?” How would you answer that?

#### 3. The appropriate response to these two truths: fear and trembling

- There is often much confusion around the word “fear” in the Bible because we are to fear God, but we are not to fear people and things. What is the difference between these two kinds of fear?
- Talk about some practical ways that fear and trembling manifest themselves in your daily walk with God?
