"Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says." James 1:22 NIV

SUMMARY

Pastor Frank taught a message entitled, "Precious Little" from 2 King 4:1-7. In this passage, we read of a widow who owed a tremendous sum, yet had "precious little" to repay. We saw how God used a man named Elisha to minister to this woman in her impossible situation.

1. Our impossible little, with God, is more than enough.

- Why do we generally dislike being in situations with "impossibly little"?
- Why does God delight in using our "impossibly little" to provide for all we need?

2. Leanness isn't a sign God isn't good, and it's not a sign our faith is bad.

- If you can, share an example from your own life that highlights this point.

5. The key to good stewardship is God's ownership.

• Good stewards check with the owners before using resources. How can you grow in the habit of praying for wisdom before using God's resources?
