APPLICATION QUESTIONS

“Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.” James 1:22 niv

SUMMARY

Pastor Tim wrapped up the final seven verses in John 14 with his teaching “Serve Others and Love Jesus.” Christ continued to communicate to His disciples the promise of the Holy Spirit, the promises of peace, protection, preparedness, and the foretelling of what will happen to Him in the coming hours.

APPLICATION

1. I want you to know someone (v.25-26)

- Have you ever been in a situation when Scripture popped into your head that was needed for that exact moment? If so, what were the circumstances, and what happened?
- The Holy Spirit’s job is to bring Jesus’ words to our remembrance. Our job is to get His words in our hearts. What are you doing regularly to get God’s Word inside of you?

2. I want to give you something (v.27)

- Knowing that His death was imminent, Jesus had peace. How is that possible?
- In what ways does the world try to offer us peace? How have these let you down in the past?
- In what situation(s) do you need the peace of Christ in your life right now?

3. I want to take you somewhere (v.28)

- Have you lost a friend, family member, or loved one who was a believer - and you know they are in heaven - but struggle with the reality that you’ll not see them again in this life?

4. I have prepared you (v.29)

- Have you ever been trained or coached? If so, how was your trainer/coach patient with you?
- Where has God been patient with you in your ‘preparation’ here on earth?

5. I will protect you (v.30)

- Our enemy wants us to think he’s in control, but he’s not. Is there a circumstance in your life that you’ve fully surrendered to God, but it seems to be in chaos and controlled by the enemy? Share the details of this situation.

6. I won’t leave you (v.31)

- In a world where things are uncertain, how does Jesus’ promise of His presence give you comfort and confidence to keep going?

PRAYER

Pray that we would experience the peace of Christ, and trust His preparation process!
