APPLICATION QUESTIONS

SUMMARY

Pastor David Guzik completed our two-part *February Fire* series with a message entitled "Identity". In this message, he looked at the life Moses and showed us five great lessons about our identity in Christ.

READ IT THROUGH

Hebrews 11:24-26 and Exodus 2:11-14

TALK IT OVER

- 1. Knowing your identity is a mark of maturity ("when he became of age" v.24)
 - What are some of the counterfeit identities that you've carried over the years?
- 2. Knowing your identity is demonstrated by life choices ("refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter" v.24)
 - Talk about a time where you, like Moses, made a decision on the basis of your true identity as a child of God?

APPLICATION

- 3. Knowing your identity will cost you something ("choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God" v.25)
 - Share about a time in life when you voluntarily forfeited something (a job, a relationship, an opportunity, etc.) because of your decision to identify with Christ.
 - Are you currently facing any such situations? If so, explain.
- 4. Knowing your identity is a matter of faith ("By faith Moses..." v.24)
 - Pastor David shared how that by faith, we are forgiven, clean, a new creation, sealed with the Holy Spirit, etc. Why do many of us struggle to believe these things are true about us?
- 5. Knowing your identity is connected to knowing Jesus the Messiah ("esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt" v.26)
 - Moving forward, how can your identity with Jesus Christ become the most important identity that you have?

PRAYER

Pray that this week we would embrace our truest identity.
