Small Group APPLICATION QUESTIONS

“Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.” James 1:22 NIV

SUMMARY

Tyler Golson taught through 1 Timothy 1:12-17 in a message entitled “The Products of the Power of Christ.” The Apostle Paul shared with Timothy the evident truth of what Christ had done for him. This written account testifies to the incredible results and dramatic gifts Paul received when he was pulled from a life of sin into a life of freedom by Christ.

Before discussing the questions, ask a volunteer from the group to take a moment to read I Timothy 1:12-17 aloud.

APPLICATION

1. In Paul’s testimony, he shared seven things that the power of Christ had produced: thanksgiving, strength, calling, mercy, grace, salvation, and patience.

- Which of these seven stood out to you the most? Why?
- What one thing can you implement this week from the “products of Christ’s power” that stood out to you?

2. Your story (or testimony) has power because of what Christ has done for you, not because of what you’ve done.

- Have you ever shared your testimony before? If so, how did it go?
- Who comes to mind as someone that you’d like to share your testimony with? What it look like to do so?

3. The reason that Paul shared his story with Timothy, who was a timid young man, was to encourage Timothy that Christ can use us in great ways.

- How does Paul’s testimony give you greater confidence in God in your own life?

4. The mercy of God is still available and waiting for those who have not yet believed.

- Who in your life do you need to pray for that they would accept the mercy and grace of God?

PRAYER

Pray that we’d have opportunity to share the story of what Christ has done in our lives!
