Small Group APPLICATION QUESTIONS

SUMMARY

Brian McKenney concluded our *Impossible* series with a message entitled, “Before the Walls Come Down” from Joshua 4-6. We learned 3 lessons (plus a bonus lesson) about how we are to live while in our waiting.

Opener

Talk about the “wall” that you are currently facing?

1. Remember the future (see Joshua 4:5-7)

Brian talked about how during the day, they saw a monument to their impossible situation (the walls of Jericho). During the night, however, they saw a monument to the ability of God (twelve stones)! What can you look back to in your life as a monument to the power of God?

APPLICATION

2. Renew your obedience (see Joshua 5:2-7)

What’s an area of your life where you were walking in obedience at one point, but are no longer living in obedience to God? How can you take a step today to “renew” your obedience?

3. Return to holy ground (see Joshua 5:13-15)

If your habit of meeting with Jesus been lacking lately, what you do to carve out time with Him?

Bonus: Let’s be found praising as the walls come down (see Joshua 6:20)

How can you grow as one who is praising and worshiping while you are waiting for the walls to come down?

PRAYER

Pray that as we are waiting for our wall to fall, we’d be found faithfully seeking God’s face!
