

Tyler Golson walked us through the final verses in our study of the book of John with his teaching, *Just Give Me Jesus*. We saw the Apostle Peter's public restoration to ministry and gleaned several good application points to consider in John 21:15-25.

Just Give Me Jesus because...

- 1. He restores us from our greatest failures.
 - Have you ever made a really bold claim only to end up where Peter was...a failure to follow through with what you said you'd do? Share your experience.
 - What lesson did you learn from that? Have you made that same mistake since?
 - Who has the greatest restoration story you've personally witnessed? Why?

2. He prepares us for the impossible.

• Peter was told his death would bring God glory. How has the Lord prepared you in a past difficulty? Looking back, can you see how He was glorified in it?

3. He focuses our busy minds on what matters.

- Why is it when we study God's Word, we tend to see truths for other people instead of ourselves?
- How has the Lord taught you to maintain focus in your time with Him despite the circumstances or hectic schedule that surrounds you?
- When is the best time for you to focus on reading His Word? What prevents you from doing that regularly?

4. He is the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

• Share a nugget of truth the Lord has shown you in the past week that helped with a specific area of your life.
