SUMMARY

Pastor Frank taught a message entitled, “Walking in the Valley of the Shadow of Death!” In this message, we looked at one of the most important passages of the entire Bible - that is, the resurrection of Jesus. We learned five things that a walk through the valley of the shadow of death can teach us!

READ IT TOGETHER

Mark 16:1-13

TALK IT OVER

1. Death stinks, but love doesn't!

In verses 1-3, the ladies came to show love. Who in your life can you show love to who is currently suffering or in pain? Without having the details worked out, what can you do?

2. Simply look up!

When you are between a rock and a hard place, where do you tend to first look for help - to God or yourself? If you are in a tough situation currently, what will it look like for you to seek God in the days to come?

3. Accept the “peculiar” invitation!

Charles Spurgeon said, “If any of you’ve behaved worse to your master than others, you’re peculiarly called to come to Him now.” Talk about a time in life when you, like Peter, accepted the “peculiar” invitation to come back to Jesus.

4. There is a place to see Jesus today!

Do you have a particular place where you meet with Jesus? If so, talk about where that place is and why it's significant.

5. Truth to troubled hearts!

The two women shared that Jesus was alive with those who were mourning. How are you at sharing the truth with people amid their sorrow? How might you improve?
