READ IT TOGETHER

Mark 9:42-50

TALK IT OVER

1. When we see God's children the way He does, we will value them differently (v.42)

Brian challenged us to remember how much Jesus loves people - even the people that can annoy us. How can you take a step towards treating *every* child of God according to the way that He sees them?

2. When we see our sin the way He does, we will act differently (v.43-48)

APPLICATION

Clearly, Jesus wants us to do whatever it takes to keep from sinning. What preventative measures do you need to take *now* to guard yourself against sin in the future?

3. When we see trials the way He does, we will respond differently (v.49)

Are you facing any trials right now? If so, how can this group pray for you?

4. When we see greatness the way He does, we will live differently (v.50)

Jesus said that we should seek to have purity (salt) within us and peace with others. What does it look like for you to pursue personal purity? Additionally, what does it look like to pursue peace with others?
