# **APPLICATION QUESTIONS**

"Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says." James 1:22 NIV

## SUMMARY

Jay Everett taught a message from John 12:42-50 with the longest title ever: "But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name." Jay left us with four practical questions to consider from this passage.

## 1. Audience: what audience are you trying to please - man or God? (See v.43)

- Why do we tend to prioritize pleasing people more than pleasing God?
- What would it look like for you to aim to please God, no matter what?

## 2. Judgment: are you judging others? (See v.47)

- What does it mean to "judge" someone?
- How can you incorporate the discipline of asking more questions before rushing to judgment?

#### 3. Authority: do you have authority in your life? (See v.49)

- What comes to mind when you hear the word "authority"?
- What are some of the benefits of being under authority?
- Under whose authority have you voluntarily placed yourself?
- If you have resisted godly authority in your life, what step(s) can you take to find that authority?

#### 4. Eternal life: do you have eternal life? (See v.50)

- Talk about when you believed in Jesus and received eternal life. What happened?
- Last weekend we asked, "Who do you need to engage in a gospel conversation this week" How did it go?

Pray that we'd live lives that are aimed at pleasing God.
