

## Where to start with Jehovah's Witnesses

Passages to avoid at first. Their "translation" the NWT either badly mistranslates it or they have ready answers, you'll spend more time arguing about the translation than the point at hand. If you do reference these passages, know what the JWs say first. There are easier passages to go to that they haven't twisted.

- Jn 1:1 – they render it that Jesus was "a god" It's not a good argument but takes time to unpack the grammar. The articles they reference from experts do not say what they claim.
- Jn 8:58 – they render "I AM" as "I have been" again, incorrect, even in their own kingdom interlinear. Exodus 3 – they misleadingly point to the LXX (EGO EIMI HO ON) instead of the Hebrew (EYEH ASHER EYEH) to conceal that Jesus references this.
- Revelation 1:11, they omit part of the verse.
- Hebrews 1:8 – they render it "God is your throne"
- Philippians 2 – they badly mistranslate this passage.
- Col 1 – they insert the word "other" many times.
- Titus 2:13 – they change it to "our great God and of our Savior Jesus Christ "

Start here:

- PS 102: 21,22. Who is being spoken of? Jehovah  
24-27 read it and compare with Heb 1:10-13. Who does the Father call Jehovah? Even their own footnote "C" references PS 102.
- IS 43:25. Who is saying this? Jehovah (vs 16). Compare with Mk 2:7
- IS 44:6 who is the First and the Last? Jehovah. Compare with Rev 1:17-18
- IS 44:8 Who is speaking? Jehovah. Is there any other rock? 2 Sam 22:2, 32, 47. Is Jehovah the rock of the OT? Compare with 1 Cor 10:4
