**Commissioned for Love**

<sup>30</sup> *And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.* <sup>31</sup> *The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbour as yourself.'* There is no other commandment greater than these." Mark 12:30-31

**Worship: Love God**
