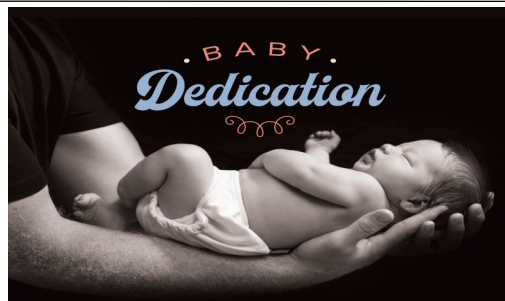

Association VBS Training - Tuesday, April 21, at WEBC from 6:00-8:00 P.M.

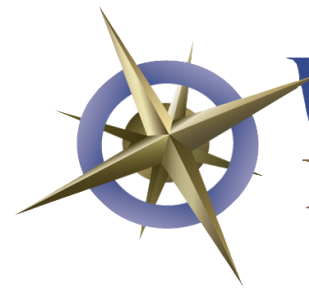

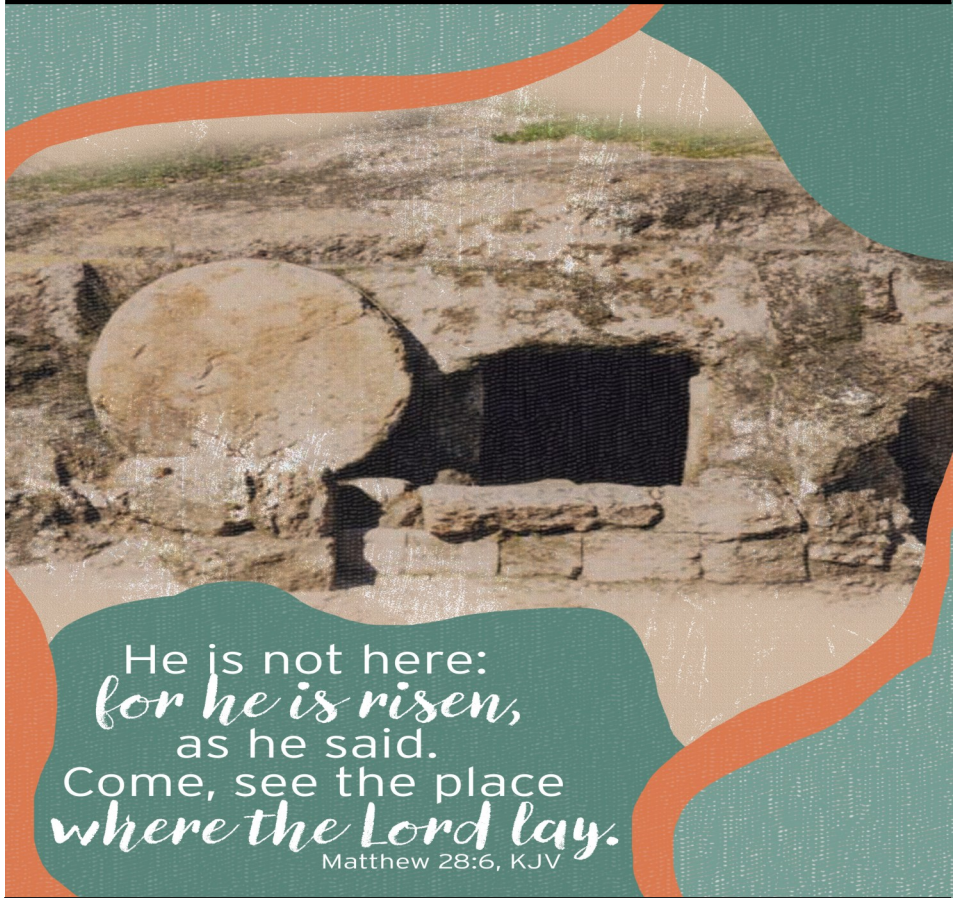
