Paul wrote this book to his spiritual son, Timothy. Paul was in prison, he was accused of taking Gentiles too far into the temple. While in prison, at the end of his life, he wrote this to Timothy.

2 Timothy 4:6-8

For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing.

1. Vision

Please take a moment to read Mark 16:15

Go and preach the gospel to **every creature**. This speaks of Geography: Go into all the world. It's not about how far you travel, but all of us need to have a vision for the all. We need to spread the good news. There is a revolution in transportation and communication. Using technology and social media we can communicate the message of Christ to all. God wants to position us for the all and the every, being obedient to where God is calling you even if it is across the street.

2. Build Multigeneratonal

God is not only interested in a broad vision but a vision of **depth**. And that takes a vision for all the generations that does not end with your generation. We need to understand our roots and foundation. We need to have prophetic insight to have prophetic foresight.

3. Disciple in every sphere of society

God is releasing people to not only minister in the church building, but He is releasing a wave of **marketplace ministers**. Work is worship and ministry. God does not only want to transform our churches but also our cities and nations. Your job is a calling. What does education, business, government, etc look like if it is baptized in the name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit?

4. The word of God in every mother tongue

God wants us to proclaim the good news into every nation and **tongue**. God understands you in your language.

REFLECTION:

- 1. Do you find yourself in a transition where you need to finish one season well before entering a new season? The way you will finish this season will determine how you enter the next season. Ask God to show you how you can live in the present season and finish well.
- 2. Do you see your job as a calling? Ask God how He can use you in your workplace.
