Jewish believers were being persecuted & were thinking about giving up on Christianity You can almost hear the Jews saying to those believers: "That religion is not right!"

They don't have **prophets** like **we** have prophets

They don't have **angels** giving the law like **we** do

They don't have a Moses like our Moses

They don't have **a Joshua** – like **our** Joshua

<u>They</u> don't even have a <u>Sabbath day</u> to rest on, or <u>priest</u> or a <u>temple</u> or <u>sacrifices</u> – <u>what kind</u> of religion is that?

The writer is saying – Christ is much more than all of Judaism!

- 4:9 There remains therefore a <u>Sabbath</u> rest for the people of God.
- V.10 For the one who has <u>entered His rest</u> has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His. (Christ is our Sabbath 7 days a week)
- V.11 Let us therefore <u>be diligent to enter</u> that rest, lest anyone fall through *following* the same example of disobedience.
- V.12 For the word of God is <u>living</u> and <u>active</u> and <u>sharper</u> than any two-edged sword, and <u>piercing</u> as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and <u>able to judge</u> the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
- V.13 <u>And</u> there is **no** creature hidden from His sight, but <u>all things are open and laid</u> <u>bare to the eyes of Him</u> with <u>whom we have to do</u>.
 - 1) "all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him"
 - a) God our **deals w/** attitudes more than our actions
 - b) **Because** God **knows** the real reason for your actions you should be honest w/ God & yourself
 - 2) "with whom we have to do"
 - a) Everyone will stand before God no choice!

Rom.2:16 on the day when, according to my gospel, <u>God</u> will judge the <u>secrets</u> of men through Christ Jesus.

2 Cor.5:10 For <u>we must all</u> appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that <u>each</u> one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, <u>according to</u> what he has done, whether <u>good</u> or <u>bad</u>.

- b) Your life is an open book before Him
 - i) He also knows the **secret good things** you have done **for Him Rom.14:10** But you, why do you judge your brother? Or you again, why do you regard your brother with contempt? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God.

c) The lost will be judged too

d) The **standard for judgment is** the **Word of God** – that <u>sharp 2</u> <u>edged sword</u>

Rev.19:11 (when Christ returns) And I saw heaven opened; and behold, a white horse, and <u>He</u> who sat upon it *is* called Faithful and True; and in righteousness He judges and wages war.

- 12 And His eyes *are* a flame of fire, and upon His head *are* many diadems; and He has a name written *upon Him* which no one knows except Himself.
- 13 And *He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood; and His name is called The Word of God.
- 14 And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses.
 15 And from His mouth comes **a sharp sword**, so that **with it** He may smite the nations; and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce

Because of **V.12-13** the truths of **V.14** are very important

V.12 x For the word of God is <u>living</u> and <u>active</u> and <u>sharper</u> than any two-edged sword, and <u>piercing</u> as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

wrath of God, the Almighty.

V.13 x <u>And</u> there is <u>no</u> creature <u>hidden</u> from His sight, but all things are open and <u>laid</u> bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to do.

V.14 Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

- 1) "Since then we have a great high priest"
 - a) He wasn't a high priest or priest at all while on earth

Mt.17:24 (NIV) And when they had come to Capernaum, those who collected the two-drachma *tax* came to Peter, and said, "Does your teacher not pay the two-drachma *tax*?"

25 He said, "Yes." And when he came into the house, Jesus spoke to him first, saying, "What do you think, Simon? From whom do the kings of the earth collect customs or poll-tax, from their sons or from strangers?"

26 And upon his saying, "From strangers," Jesus said to him, "Consequently the sons are exempt.

27 "But, lest we give them offense, go to the sea, and throw in a hook, and take the first fish that comes up; and when you open its mouth, you will find a stater. Take that and give it to them for you and Me."

- b) **Priest** were **exempt** from **temple tax**
- c) He was<u>n't</u> from tribe of **Levi** (priestly tribe) <u>but</u> from **Judah**
- d) He was <u>declared</u> to be a <u>Prophet</u> on earth

 Acts 3:22 (Peter quoting <u>Deut.18:15</u>)(NIV) For Moses said, 'The

 Lord your God will raise up for you <u>a prophet</u>(Jesus) <u>like me</u>

 from among your own people; you must listen to everything he tells you.
- e) All Israel was <u>looking</u> for that <u>Prophet</u> Moses talked about
 - i) They did<u>n't realize</u> that the <u>Prophet</u> & the <u>Messiah</u> were the same Person

Jn.7:40 On hearing his words, some of the people <u>said</u>, "Surely this man is <u>the Prophet</u>."

41 Others <u>said</u>, "He is <u>the Christ</u>." Still others asked, "How can the Christ come from Galilee?

- f) But <u>after His ascension</u> He became our <u>High Priest</u>
- g) **Some day** He will be **crowned King** of all creation
 - i) Then He will have **filled** <u>all 3 roles</u>: <u>**Prophet**</u>, <u>**Priest**</u> and <u>**King**</u>
- h) **The world's idea** of a **priest** does<u>n't</u> help us understand the <u>true</u> <u>Priest</u>
 - The world sees the priest as actually <u>halting</u> progress to God
 - ii) In Romanism you <u>only</u> get so close to God <u>then</u> you have to go <u>thru</u> a priest to get closer
 - iii) It is <u>as if</u> there is a <u>barrier</u> between <u>you & God</u> that **only** the <u>priest can navigate</u>
 - iv) In the <u>O.T.</u> that was <u>true</u> & in <u>paganism</u> it is <u>believed</u> true
- i) Job <u>longed</u> for a mediator / <u>priest</u>
 Job9:33(NIV) <u>If only there were someone</u> to <u>arbitrate</u>
 between us, to lay his hand upon us both,
- j) We have that Mediator

1 Jn.2:1 My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an <u>advocate</u> with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.

V.14 x (NP)

V.14 x <u>Since then we have a great high priest</u> <u>who has passed through the heavens</u>, **Jesus** the Son of God, let us <u>hold fast</u> our confession.

- 1) x "Since then we have a **great** high priest"
 - a) He is**n't** just a High Priest but the "**Great"** high Priest
 - b) He is **great** b/c of His **position** (where He is)
- 2) "who has passed through the heavens"
 - a) He has passed thru the **heavens** of <u>our atmosphere</u>
 - b) He passed thru the **planetary** <u>heavens</u>
 - c) He **entered** the **3rd heaven** where God dwells
 - **2 Cor.12:2** I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago-- whether in the body I do not know, or out of the body I do not know, God knows-- such a man was caught up to the **third** heaven.
 - **V.4** was caught up into <u>Paradise</u>, and heard inexpressible words, which a man is not permitted to speak.
 - d) <u>Perfect tense</u> a <u>completed action</u> having **current results**
 - e) Christ **dwells** where **no mortal** man could live
 - f) Aaron, who served as high priest, & all the high priest after him stopped at the veil that divided the Holy place from the Most Holy place
 - i) <u>In the Tabernacle</u> & later <u>the Temple</u> there was that <u>small</u>, <u>cube shaped room</u> the **Holy of Holies where <u>no</u> man ventured**
 - ii) Only on **one** day, every year, was the high priest **allowed** to go into that room & that was to <u>make atonement for Israel</u>
 - iii) The <u>reason</u> they could<u>n't</u> go in that room God's presence <u>dwelled</u> there above the mercy seat
 - iv) <u>If</u> a <u>priest</u> or the <u>High Priest</u> went in <u>any other time</u> it was a <u>death sentence</u>
 - **Lev.16:2** And the LORD said to Moses, "Tell your brother Aaron that he shall <u>not</u> enter at any time into the holy place inside the veil, before the mercy seat which is on the ark, <u>lest he die</u>; for I will appear in the cloud over the mercy seat.
 - g) <u>Jesus</u> not only went <u>into</u> the <u>Tabernacle</u> **He** <u>went</u> into the <u>real</u> <u>Tabernacle</u> the one in Heaven
 - i) But <u>He</u> also went into the Holy of Holies where God dwells

- ii) He <u>didn't just</u> go in there He <u>sat down</u> at the <u>right hand of</u> God and there He <u>remains</u> unto this day
- iii) He went where no mortal man could go even though HE is a man
- h) Jesus is <u>always</u> in **God's presence** making <u>intercession</u> for us **Rom.8:34** who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, <u>who also intercedes for us</u>.
- i) When the writer <u>says</u> He is a "<u>great</u>" high Priest <u>He is great!</u>
 - i) **Because** He is able to **dwell** in the **presence** of God

V.14 x Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, **Jesus** the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

- 1) "**Jesus** the Son of God"
 - a) There is **another reason** Jesus is our "**Great**" High Priest
 - b) It is found in the statement "Jesus the Son of God"
 - c) "Son of God" is a title it speaks of His <u>divinity</u> <u>He is God!</u>
 - i) He has always been God

Jn.1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

- d) **But** the name "<u>Jesus</u>" is His **human name** It **speaks** of His **humanity**
- e) When it says "<u>Jesus the Son of God</u>" it is declaring **He is God** & **He is man** 100% God & 100% man
- f) There is **something** in Heaven that did**n't** exist before the ascension
- g) There is a man in Heaven

1 Tim.2:5 For there is one God, *and* one <u>mediator</u> also between God and men, *the* <u>man</u> Christ Jesus,

- h) **Job wanted someone** to **take** <u>God's hand</u> & <u>his</u> hand & <u>join the 2</u> <u>together</u> reconcile them
 - i) **Because** <u>HE is God</u> & <u>man</u> **He can grasp** the **hand of God** & **the hand of man** & <u>unite</u> the 2

Job9:32(NIV) "He is not a man like me that I might answer him, that we might confront each other in court.

33 If only there were someone to arbitrate between us, to lay his hand upon us both,

i) **Now** there is **a man like Job** who can **arbitrate** & <u>we are to take</u> advantage of that (NP)

V.14 x Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, **Jesus** the Son of God, let us *hold fast our confession*.

- 2) "hold fast our confession"
 - a) to take hold of, take, seize, to hold fast, i.e. not discard or let go, to continue to hold, to retain
 - b) **Literally** "Let us keep on holding fast."
 - c) **Subjunctive** mood <u>your choice</u>
 - d) Notice he didn't say to hold fast our salvation
 - i) We are to hold fast our confession our testimony
 - e) God's idea of a "great" high priest is someone who opens the way for us to go to God V.15 & 16
- V.15 **For** we do not have a high priest who cannot <u>sympathize with our weaknesses</u>, b<u>ut One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin.</u>
 - 1) "sympathize with our weaknesses"
 - a) Since He was 100 % man He **understands** what temptation is
 - i) HE **understands** <u>human infirmity</u> b/c He has felt it just like you have
 - ii) He **felt** what it is to be: <u>weary</u>, <u>hungry</u>, <u>thirsty</u>, in <u>pain</u>, <u>afraid</u>
 - iii) He **knows what it is** to **obey** the Father's will when He **did<u>n't</u>** really want to

Mt.26:38 Then He said to them, " My soul is deeply grieved, to the point of death; remain here and keep watch with Me."

39 And He went a little beyond *them,* and fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, <u>if it is possible</u>, <u>let this cup pass from Me</u>; yet not as I will, but as Thou wilt."

b) His humanity **created a heart of sympathy** for us

Heb.2:17 Therefore, He had to be made like His brethren in all things, that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

18 For since He Himself was tempted in that which He has suffered, <u>He is able to come to the aid of those who are</u> tempted.

C)

- 2) "but One who has been tempted in all things as we are yet without sin"
 - a) He **knew** the <u>assault</u> of temptation in ways <u>we don't</u> <u>b/c</u> He was sinless & didn't yield.

Lk.4:13 (NP)

Lk.4:13 And when the devil had finished **every** temptation, he departed from Him until an opportune time.

- V.16 <u>Let us therefore draw ne</u>ar wit<u>h confidence</u> to the <u>throne of grace</u>, that <u>we may</u> receive mercy and may find grace to help in time of need.
 - 1) "Let us therefore draw near"
 - a) It <u>only makes sense</u> to draw near to the One who <u>totally understands</u> & <u>can help</u>
 - b) But it is in subjunctive mood
 - c) It is **our choice** to draw near
 - 2) "with confidence"
 - a) "confidence" <u>Freedom of speaking</u>, <u>unreserved speech</u>, <u>w/out</u> concealment, fearless confidence, assurance
 - b) You draw near & **be totally honest** w/ God
 - c) Come w/ reverence but be honest in your approach
 - 3) "throne of grace"
 - a) What a **beautiful description** is our **place of refuge**
 - b) You come <u>all beat up</u>, <u>frazzled</u>, <u>too weak to fight back</u> the invitation is to "<u>come</u>"
 - c) WE come that "we may find mercy"
 - 4) "we may receive mercy"
 - a) Mercy is what I want I don't want justice I don't want "my share"!
 - b) I want someone to have pity on my defeated state
 - c) I want help!
 - 5) "may find grace to help in time of need"
 - a) I need God's help every day every hour
 - b) Do you see God as wanting to help you navigate this life successfully?
 - c) If not You don't have a realistic picture of Who God is
 - d) What makes our High Priest so great?
 - e) He doesn't block our way to God He makes our way to Him
 - f) He stands us up strengthening us, cleanses us makes us able to stand in God's presence & receive His mercy
- **Jude1:24** Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy,
- 25 to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, *be* glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.
