Review:

- 1) We are to have a certain type of fear!!! **V.1**
- V.1 Therefore, <u>let us fear</u> lest, while <u>a</u> promise remains of entering His rest, any one of you should seem to have come short of it.
 - 1) "let us fear...while a promise remains of entering His rest...any...of you should...come short"
 - a) It is entirely possible to miss what God has for us in this life
 - b) How easy is it to miss what God has for us?
 - i) You simply ignore the Word of God & you've done it! V.2
- V.2 For indeed <u>we</u> have had good news preached to us, just as they also; **but** the word they heard <u>did not profit them</u>, **because** <u>it was not united by faith</u> in those who heard.
 - *You must **incorporate the Word** of God in your own **life** for it to have value *You may be afraid to be obedient do it anyway
- V.7 He again fixes a certain day, "Today," saying through David after so long a time just as has been said before, "TODAY IF YOU HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS."
- V.8 For <u>if Joshua had given them rest, He would **not** have spoken of another day</u> after that.
 - 1) "if Joshua had given them rest, He would **not have spoken** of another day"
 - a) Literally "He would not be speaking of another day"
 - b) David wrote of a rest that is available today hundreds of years after Joshua
 - c) Jesus is better than Joshua His rest is better than Josh's rest
 - i) <u>Jesus offers a rest</u> that Joshua could<u>n't</u> <u>offer</u>
 - ii) Canaan rest is only a picture of the real rest in Christ
 - d) Even the Sabbath rest was **only a picture** of the <u>real</u> thing **V.9**
- V.9 There remains therefore <u>a Sabbath rest for the people of God</u>.
 - 1) "a **Sabbath rest** for the people of God"
 - a) The <u>word</u> "<u>rest</u>" is **different word** here than all other "rest" mentioned in this passage
 - b) The word is "σαββατισμός" we get our word sabbatical from it
 - c) There is a <u>Sabbath's rest</u> **for** <u>believers</u> today <u>it is a sabbatical</u>
 - d) We are to <u>rest in Him</u> all the time
 - e) Our Sabbath day is <u>Saturday</u> also <u>Sunday</u>, <u>Monday</u>, <u>Tuesday</u>...
 - f) Spiritually speaking every day is a holiday in Christ **V.10**

- V.10 For <u>the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works</u>, as God did from His.
 - 1) "the one who has entered His rest has himself...rested from his works"
 - a) This **simply states** that anyone who enters the rest God gives **ceases from his own labor**
 - b) When Christ says in **Mt.11** "...my yoke is easy & my burden light." HE meant it!

Mt.11:28 " Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and <u>I will give you rest</u>. (I will rest you)

29 "Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart; and <u>YOU SHALL FIND REST</u> FOR YOUR SOULS.

30 "For My yoke is <u>easy</u> (kindly – virtuous – serviceable), and My load is <u>light</u>."

- V.11 Let us therefore **be diligent** (work hard to hurry) to enter that rest, lest anyone fall through *following* the same example of disobedience.
- V.12 <u>For</u> the <u>word of God is</u> $\frac{\#1.}{living}$ and $\frac{\#2.}{living}$ and $\frac{\#3.}{living}$ and $\frac{\#3.}{living}$ and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and $\frac{\#4.}{living}$ able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
 - 1) "For"
 - a) This takes us back to what we just studied
 - i) He wants \underline{us} to know the $\underline{character}$ of the word they ignored
 - ii) They didn't mix the Word w/ faith so of no value to them
 - iii) But he wants <u>us</u> to know that the Word <u>is</u> powerful
 - 2) "word of God is <u>living</u>"
 - a) The <u>Word of God</u> is **different** than <u>any other</u> **printed**, **written**, **spoken** <u>thought</u> / <u>idea</u>
 - b) It is alive it has literal life in it
 - i) When Christ spoke in a parable about the Word of God He used a seed

Lk.8:11 "Now the parable is this: the seed is the word of God.

- ii) A seed has life in it
- c) The word "living" is " $\zeta \omega \nu$ " we get the word zoo from it (place of living creatures)
- d) Listen to what the word says about itself **Jn.6:63 (NP)**

Jn.6:63 " It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the **words** that I have spoken to you are **spirit** and are **life**.

1 Pet.1:23 for you have been born again **not** of seed which is perishable but imperishable, *that is,* through the living and enduring word of God.

- e) There is a **vast difference** between **men's** words and **God's** words
 - i) It is <u>important</u> that you <u>distinguish</u> that <u>difference</u>
 - ii) **Men** say things & it means **nothing** they threaten they promise & maybe it will be so & maybe not
 - iii) **Don't** accidentally put God in that category
 - iv) Paul <u>commended</u> the Thessalonians for being able to <u>see the</u> difference

1 Thes.2:13 And for this reason we also constantly thank God that when you received from us the word of God's message, you accepted *it* not *as* the word of men, but *for* **what it really is**, the word of God, which also performs its work in you who believe.

f) God's word **cleanses** us from the inside

Jn.17:17 " Sanctify them in the truth; Thy word is truth. **Eph.5:26**(speaking of Christ cleansing the Church) that He might sanctify her, <u>having cleansed her</u> by the washing of water with the word,

h) The Word takes an average man & **gives him great wisdom**

Ps.119:99 I have <u>more insight</u> than all my teachers, For Thy <u>testimonies</u> <u>are my meditation</u>.

V.100 <u>I understand more</u> than the aged, Because I have observed Thy precepts.

V.101 I have <u>restrained</u> my feet from every evil way, That <u>I</u> may keep Thy word.

V.102 I have not turned aside from Thine ordinances, For Thou Thyself hast taught me.

V.103 How sweet are Thy words to my taste! *Yes, sweeter* than honey to my mouth!

V.104 <u>From Thy precepts</u> I get <u>understanding</u>; Therefore I hate every false way.

V.130 The <u>unfolding</u> of Thy words <u>gives light</u>; It gives <u>understanding to the simple</u>.

i) It gives people direction in life

Ps.119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.

j) The Word of God is **hated** by the world

Jer.23:29 29 "Is not **My word** <u>like fire</u>?" declares the LORD, "and like a hammer which shatters a rock?

k) People have / will **die** for their belief in the Word

Rev.20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of the testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark upon their forehead and upon their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

V.12 x For the word of God is *1. living and *2. active and *3. sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and *4. able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

- 3) "the Word of God is living and $\frac{\#2}{}$ active"
 - a) The word "active" is " $\dot{\epsilon}\nu\epsilon\rho\gamma\dot{\eta}\varsigma$ "
 - i) We get our word energy from it
 - b) <u>Because it is alive</u> there is an <u>energy</u> that is <u>inherent</u> to it **Rom.1:16** For I am not ashamed of the <u>gospel</u>, for <u>it is</u>

 <u>the power</u> of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
 - c) That is the reason I use so much Bible
 - i) There is a **work** that the Word does on its own
 - ii) We are to read the Word publicly

1 Tim.4:13 Until I come, give attention to the <u>public</u> reading of Scripture, to <u>exhortation</u> and <u>teaching</u>.

V.12 x For the word of God is **1. living and **2. active_and **3. sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and **4. able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

- 4) "sharper than any two-edged sword"
 - a) Nothing compares to the cutting ability of the Word of God
 - b) It can separate the soul from the spirit

V.12 "...piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit..."

- c) This means <u>only the Word of God</u> can tell you when you are living in your flesh & when living in your spirit
 - i) Believers are made of body, soul, spirit
 - ii) Your spirit is made to function under the guidance of the Holy Spirit
 - iii) Your **spirit** only **functions** properly in conjunction w/ Holy Spirit
- d) Your **soul** is the part of you that makes your **personality**
- e) Your <u>soul</u> works will take directions from the <u>world</u>, your <u>flesh</u>, the <u>devil</u> & <u>if you are a believer</u> your <u>spirit</u> –
- f) We <u>believers</u> are <u>complicated beings</u> our **inner lives** are a **mixture** of emotions & truth
 - i) There are times when **our motives** could be **good** or **bad**
 - ii) You can give money away b/c you want to help Or b/c you hope God will give you more money
 - iii) You can <u>share your testimony</u> b/c you care or b/c <u>it makes you look good</u> (sometimes it is hard to know why you're doing it)
- g) So how can you possibly know which is working at a given moment?i) Look at **V.12** again
- V.12 x For the word of God is $^{#1}$ living and $^{#2}$ active and $^{#3}$ sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and $^{#4}$ able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
 - 5) "#4. able to **iudge** the thoughts and intentions of the heart"
 - a) The word so sharp that it can discern your thoughts & intentions
 - i) But we <u>must have the Word in our lives</u> for it to help **Ps.119:11** I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.
 - ii) It is **impossible** to **live** for God **w/out** His word in your heart
 - iii) There has been much said about being filled w/ the Spirit of God
 - iv) And rightly so you ca<u>n't</u> live right <u>w/out the Spirit's guidance</u> **Eph.5:18**
- **Eph.5:18** And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but <u>be filled with the Spirit</u>,
- V.19 speaking to one another in Psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord; V.20 (NP)

V.20 always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father;

V.21 and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ.

Compare this to **Col.3:16**

Col.3:16 Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with Psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

V.17 And whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

I do<u>n't</u> see how anyone can be **filled** w/ **Holy Spirit** & <u>not</u> be **filled w/ His Word** They go hand in hand

Do you know what I would do if I were Satan? – I would <u>minimize</u> The **Word of God** – in the <u>Church</u> – in <u>believer's lives</u>

<u>IF</u> it is impossible to live the Christian life w/out knowing the Word why is it:

- 1) Why do we act like knowing His Word is **optional**?
- 2) Why is it, we think going to church is good **enough** does**n't** matter much what is taught?
- 3) Why do **good people** let their children **decide** where they go to church
- 4) Why do so many parents <u>let</u> their <u>children</u> go <u>to church</u> where Bible <u>isn't</u> taught?
 - a) Because <u>they believe</u> **any** <u>church</u> is <u>better</u> than <u>**no**</u> <u>church</u>
- 5) AS goes Europe so goes America
 - a) **Europe** is full of **big**, **beautiful**, **empty** <u>cathedrals</u> Christianity was alive there at one time but **they began to ignore the Word**
 - b) What percentage of individuals believe religion has no value in life
 - c) <u>Sweden</u> 83% <u>Denmark</u> 80% <u>Norway</u> 78% <u>France</u> 73% United Kingdom 71%
- 6) This all started when the Word of God began to be marginalized by the church itself
- 7) **In your hand**, you hold **something** that is **magnificent** something that can **guide you** & your **family** & your **nation**
- 8) It holds the **answers** to **life's deepest questions**
- 9) You hold the **knowledge** of our **future**
- 10)**If your world falls apart** <u>in your hand</u> is the **one** <u>tangible</u> thing that is <u>immutable</u> THE WORD OF GOD

V.13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but <u>all things are open and laid</u> <u>bare to the eyes of Him</u> with <u>whom we have to do</u>.

- 1) "all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him"
 - The understanding that God always knows the real reason behind your actions will cause you to become honest w/ yourself quicker than anything else
 - b) If God knows the real reason I might as well look at it too
- 2) "with whom we have to do"
 - a) Nothing will encourage you to live upright more than remembering that someday we will give an account of our actions
 - b) We must do business w/ God we have no choice
 - c) Your life is an open book before Him

Someday Christ is going to come back & He will judge this world by His standards. His standards are His Word – "The Word of God"

Rev.19:11 And I saw heaven opened; and behold, a white horse, and He who sat upon it *is* called Faithful and True; and in righteousness He judges and wages war.

- 12 And His eyes *are* a flame of fire, and upon His head *are* many diadems; and He has a name written *upon Him* which no one knows except Himself.
- 13 And *He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood; and His name is called The Word of God.
- 14 And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses.
- 15 And from His mouth comes <u>a sharp sword</u>, so that <u>with it</u> He may smite the nations; and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty.
