

Event	Scripture	Description	Purpose
Rapture	1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11 John 14:1-4 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12	-The Church is raptured, or taken to heaven. -Jesus Comes to get the church and meets them in the clouds.	-The Church is not destined for Wrath. -The restrainer (Holy Spirit) has to be taken off the earth so that the man of Lawlessness (Antichrist) can be revealed. The Church must go to heaven with the Holy Spirit because we are sealed in Him.
Tribulation	Revelation 4-18 Daniel 2:41-44 Daniel 9:24-27	-7 year period (Daniels 70 <sup>th</sup> week) where Jesus pours out wrath on the earth. -This period starts with a peace treaty between the Anti-Christ and Israel, and ends with the second coming of Jesus. -The tribulation is full of both natural and supernatural calamities. -There will be a Jewish temple during the period. -The second half of the tribulation (3.5 years) is known as the Great Tribulation.	-Once the church age ends with the rapture, God's focus turns back to Israel. -The 7 year tribulation period is the last 7 years prophesied about by Daniel. -It is a time where Jesus judges the world and reveals Himself. -It will be a time of great revival and many will be saved during this period Revelation 7.
Bema Seat	1 Corinthians 3:10-18 2 Corinthians 5:9-10 Romans 14:10-12 Revelation 4:10-11	-This is for believers only and will take place in heaven <b>after</b> the rapture and sometime <b>during</b> the tribulation period. -Believers will be rewarded for the eternal things.	-The Bema Seat is a purifying fire that will separate the earthly and the eternal in a believer's life. -The purpose of the bema seat is rewards that are then used to worship God.
Marriage Supper of the Lamb	Revelation 19:6-10	-The Bride (Church) and the Groom (Jesus) are finally united. -This event takes place in heaven during the tribulation.	-Once the Church is pure after the Bema seat, she can be presented to her groom. The Church is richly blessed as the tribulation is happening on earth.
Jesus Second Coming	Revelation 19:11-21 Dan 2:44 Matthew 24:27-42 Zechariah 14:4 1 Thessalonians 3:11-13	-Jesus comes back to earth with the Church accompanying Him. -This marks the end of the 7-year tribulation period. -Jesus comes physically down to earth.	-Jesus comes back to earth as the conquering King. -The Second Coming ushers in the Millennial Reign.
Millennial Kingdom	Revelation 20 :1-6	-See back of Chart for more detailed description. -Jesus physically ruling and reigning on earth with the Church. -Any Tribulation believer left alive after tribulation will enter in mortal body.	-Jesus will fulfill many promises to Israel concerning land and an ultimate judgment on evil nations.
Satan Released and Permanently defeated	Revelation 20:7-10	-After the 1000 years is over Satan is released, and then defeated.	-Only mortals will be able to join Satan's rebellion.
Resurrection of all Non-believers	Revelation 20:13	-All non-believers are resurrected for a final judgment.	-We are eternal beings and sin must be dealt with.
Great White Throne Judgment	Revelation 20:11-15	-All nonbelievers are judged based on there works.	-All at the great white throne will be found guilty and sent to Hell.
New Heaven, New Earth and New Jerusalem	Revelation 21:1-27	-The current earth and Heaven pass away and God makes a new Heaven and Earth. The New Jerusalem Descends from Heaven.	-Very little is said about the New heaven and Earth. -It will be perfect and we will be in God's presence.

## **THE MILLENNIAL REIGN OF CHRIST (1,000 YEARS)**

Jesus will be King (Isa. 9:6) of the Earth,

ruling from Jerusalem (Mic. 4:1-2)

for 1,000 years (Rv. 20:1-6; Zch. 14:9, 16; Isa. 2:1-4, 11:1-10, 35:1-10),

where the nations will come to worship (Zch. 14:16)

and learn of God's ways (Mic. 4:2; Zch. 8:3).

The Millennium will start off with believers only (Jn. 3:3; Mt. 25:31-34, 41, 46)

and will be marked by a unified government (Hos. 1:11),

where church age believers and Tribulation martyrs will co-reign with Christ (Rv. 20:6; 2 Tim. 2:12).

David will be the prince of Israel (Ezk. 34:22-24);

Jesus's apostles will judge the twelve tribes of Israel (Mt.19:28; Lk. 22:29-30);

all weapons of war will be destroyed (Isa. 2:4);

there will be no wars (Mic. 4:3);

there will be a worldwide knowledge of God (Isa. 11:9),

peace (Isa. 9:6-7),

justice (Isa.11:3-5),

obedience (Dan. 7:27),

holiness (Ezk. 36:24-31, 37:23-24),

the fullness of the Holy Spirit (Joel 2:28-29)

and an increase in joy (Isa. 9:3-4, 14:7).

Children will be born (Isa.11:6, 65:20, 23; Jer. 30:20)

by those in their natural bodies (i.e., survivors of the Tribulation and their offspring).

There will also be a prolonged life expectancy for those in their natural bodies.

There will be comfort for those who would sorrow (Isa.12:1, 35:10, 65:19),

a removal of sickness (Isa. 33:24, Jer. 30:17),

healing of the deformed (Isa. 35:5-6),

fruitful, enjoyable labor (Isa. 62-8-9, 65:21-23),

one language (Zeph.3:9),

a change in the nature of ferocious animals (Isa.11:6-9; Ezk. 34:25, Isa. 65:25),

wonderful changes to the environment (Isa. 35:1-2, 6b-7, 55:13)

and a Millennial temple in Jerusalem where sacrifices will be made in remembrance to Christ's death (Ezk. 40-46).
