“Come, let us tell of the Lord’s greatness; let us exalt his name together. 4 I prayed to the Lord, and he answered me. He freed me from all my fears.” (Psalm 34:3-4 NLT)

There are so many things in this world to draw us our attention to a negative space. We find ourselves focused on difficulties, challenging circumstances, uncertain situations. We often find our focus upon what we do not have, as opposed to the good and blessed that we have.

David said in Psalm 34, “Let all who are discouraged take heart. Come let’s talk about God’s goodness. I prayed and the Lord answered my prayer.” He is reminding us that when we are discouraged, it’s time to talk about God. It’s time to tell of the Red Sea partings in our lives, and not talk about the enemy, or the fear of death [or other fears we face]. We should talk about God’s greatness!

What you say in your tough times will make or break you. The more you talk of the good things God has done, the less room there is for the bad things the devil is trying to do. Your focus is on the God, the “I Am,” and not the devil! And you know that if He did it in the past, He will do it in the future.
