According to Joel 2:12, fasting is a time for us to turn our hearts back to God. It is a practice that we do privately as believers which in return produces outward and inward results.

- *Strongholds and yokes to be broken (Isaiah 58:6)*
- *A newness of life to spring forth. (Isaiah 58)*

As a church God is desirous to fill our vats with new wine to carry a fresh anointing. God is calling us to lay down idols, barriers, ideals, habits, etc., that have impaired our ability to walk in the fullness of what God has ordained for our lives. We are in expectation that **The BREAKERS FAST** is going to:
