NEXT STEPS:

Dan Bolkema and John Klumpp: Candidates for Pastoral Positions

We believe that God is calling current Executive Director Dan Bolkema and current Children's Ministry Director John Klumpp to new pastoral positions at Wellspring Church. Your vote on December 8 as a member of Wellspring Church will be to affirm these calls so that Dan and John can begin the ordination process to fulfill the calling to become Pastors.

According to the Wellspring Church constitution, the congregation must vote for all pastoral staff hires. We define a "pastor" as someone who has been vetted by a body of elders and other pastors who affirm their call to the ministry. This is what we call the ordination process. Wellspring has a process that takes about a year to complete for an individual to go through ordination to be hired as an ordained pastor. It is our belief that Dan and John are ready to begin this process.

It would not be fair to either them or you as a congregation to have them start the ordination process nor begin transitioning into these much-needed positions without you first affirming this call that they are indeed the ones God is specifically calling to be pastors in these two key areas.

Executive Pastor

The first position is called the Executive Pastor. This is a role for someone who hears the call of God to be a Pastor and whose giftedness is more in the area of administration and leading an organization as opposed to having an emphasis on ministerial work—preaching, teaching, pastoral counseling, weddings, funerals and more. An Executive Pastor is an ordained position and can certainly function in these ministerial roles as their giftedness and time permit, but their primary role is to oversee the daily operations of a church, freeing up the other Pastors whose focus is more on ministerial duties.



While the primary role of many pastors is shepherding the

health of the body, the primary role of the Executive Pastor is shepherding the health of the organization. His job is to connect all the various ministries back to the mission of the church, and ensure that all of the ministries are working together towards a common vision, rather than being isolated from each other.

An Executive Pastor directly reports to the Lead Pastor—myself—who in turn reports to the Elders.

As a church grows, it is important that the Lead Pastor is able to focus primarily on ministerial duties and calling, rather than attempting to also include oversight of the administrative functions of the daily operations and all of the various ministries. Thus, the Executive Pastor's position's primary goal is to make sure that the daily operations of the church are running in a Godly, effective, healthy manner, and is functioning in line with the constitution and in line with the Elder's decisions and overall leadership.

The Elders and I believe that God is calling Dan Bolkema to be the Executive Pastor at Wellspring. Dan spent years establishing and running his own business, and after answering God's call to vocational ministry, earned a degree in Ministry Leadership. This life experience along with his gift set equips him well to function in this role.

Associate Pastor

The main responsibility of the Associate Pastor is to share in the ministerial duties of the Lead Pastor. This person will share the load of preaching, pastoral counseling, weddings, visitation, and other such ministerial duties of the church.

The elders and I believe that God has highlighted John Klumpp as the ideal candidate for this position. He has worked as Wellspring's Director of Children's Ministry over the past five, and more recently has been helping with preaching on Sunday mornings as well as performing weddings and funerals. We believe that God has been preparing both John and us for him to take this role of Associate Pastor.
