ADVENT WEEK ONE: A BLESSED HOPE

Bursting with anticipation, a little girl peers out of a glittering glass window. Navigating the encased frost filled edges of frozen morning dew, she presses her face against the pane. With her eyes fixed on the long winding drive and her excitement unable to be tamed, she settles in for the big arrival. Then, in a sudden shriek of joy, she announces for all to hear, "They are coming! They are coming!"

Advent, that time of year, when we too wait with expectancy. The word "advent" is derived from the Latin word adventus, which means "coming". The first mention of advent in church history was around the fourth century, yet by the fifth and sixth centuries advent was common church practice. The season of advent calls to us as it did the early church, to concentrate our hearts on Christ. During the four Sunday's leading up to Christmas, we will focus on the hope, love, joy, and peace of Jesus. We look not only to the birth of Christ, but also to His return. In this advent season, the corporate call to our church body is to reflect on the person who is the Christ. A beloved bellowing found in scripture and authored from the throne room of heaven declares,

For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6

In a word, Isaiah shouts to the world, hope. Hope is coming! Indeed, hope has come, and hope remains. Like the child awaiting the coming of her grandparents, we too await with confidence the future coming of Christ. And in this Christmas season, we celebrate the hope which has already come in Jesus Christ.

It is important to remember this hope isn't *for* something, though it includes that, rather this hope is *in* someone—Jesus. In the person of Christ, we have hope. As the days tick by and we walk toward that bed of scratchy straw to peek into the manger, straining to catch a glimpse of Isaiah's heralded child, we rejoice! Can you picture that first Christmas day and what it must have been like when the world saw hope, in the flesh, revealed?

Luke tells us how the shepherds reacted when the coming hope arrived:

The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen.
Luke 2:20

On that first Christmas, with faces pressed firm against the glass, the shepherds saw hope. We too press against the pane, awaiting with great expectation the second advent.

In the days ahead, let us prepare our hearts for the Christmas season and for the mighty return of our Lord. In this first week, may we reflect upon the glorious truths that hope came, hope is here, hope is coming again, and hope has a name—Jesus!
