Today, the world mourns the loss of one of God's most fearless creations.

Anthony was born on August 18, 1980, to Maeola Ellis Lee (d. 2000) and Frank C. Williams. He was a graduate of Miami Edison Senior High School and was a lifelong resident of Miami, Florida. From the moment he was born, Anthony faced more adversity than most could imagine. Yet, as a child he was the apple of everyone's eyes and the center of attention; not because of his health issues, but because of his beauty and his joy. He was never defined or limited by his conditions in his mind or his heart. From day one, his family lived with the knowledge that he could be taken at any time. Health experts suggested that Anthony wouldn't live to see his 10th birthday, but Anthony left this world at the age of 42. In true Anthony fashion, he defied those odds.

Anthony craved independence more than anything and he worked to achieve it without fear. The concern that others had for him created a bubble and he did all he could to appreciate it, but he wanted what he wanted. Being told he would never live on his own was a challenge that Anthony faced head on and proved everyone wrong. Some of his proudest moments involved showing people his apartment or the meals he cooked. The independence he craved and created was celebrated by many, including the one person who walked that very thin line of protector and inspirer. Anthony said, "Auntie, I want my own place." Even through her fear for him, his aunt, Gloria J. Williams did all she could because of her love for him. Anthony defied the odds.

Anthony had a faith that couldn't be shaken. This faith was displayed in his love for God, and his love for God's Church. While his mother was a member of Christian Fellowship under the pastorate of the late Pastor Charles Coleman, Anthony went to services with his Auntie at Mt. Calvary M.B. Church and then to God is Love Prayer & Mission Center under the leadership of Pastor Shirley M. Hughley. As he developed, he would serve as Apostle Hughley-Schenck's armor-bearer. In 2015, after a period of searching for a church home, Anthony united with I Love You Jesus Ministries, Inc. under the leadership of D. Lavon Williams. He was ordained as a minister and also served on the Praise Team until 2018. He loved old school Gospel music and was often viewed on social media singing, praying, and preaching. In 2014, Anthony connected with Apostle A. Marquis Hairston, Sr., who he affectionately called "Dad", and when the City Church of Charlotte, NC was founded, Anthony regularly attended virtually and became a founding member. In 2018, Anthony founded the Victory Broadcast, which is a virtual ministry of evangelism and encouragement. He was ordained to Eldership in June of 2020 in the first-ever Service of Elevation & Ordination of the Beautiful City of Zion Evangelistic Ministries, founded by Apostle Hairston. Anthony defied the odds.

Anthony's love of God was seen through his love of others. He never met a stranger and treated everyone with grace. He came into this world and brought us love. He came into this world and brought us joy. He came into this world and brought us understanding. But most of all, Anthony came into this world and brought us hope; a hope that we could be as brave, bold, and resilient as he was.
