Psalm 100 PREPARATION, ANTICIPATION, AND PARTICIPATION IN WORSHIP

Psalm 100

Is all about WORSHIP, THANKSGIVING, and PRAISE

- I. MAKE A JOYFUL NOISE UNTO THE LORD, ALL YE LANDS. (Psalm 100:1) (Ephesians 5:18-20/Colossians 3:16-25)
- II. SERVE THE LORD WITH GLADNESS! COME BEFORE HIS PRESENCE WITH SINGING (Psalm 100:2)
- III. KNOW YE THAT THE LORD HE IS GOD: IT IS HE THAT HATH MADE US, AND NOT WE OURSELVES; WE ARE HIS PEOPLE, AND THE SHEEP OF HIS PASTURE. (Psalm 100:3) (1 Kings 18:39/Matthew 16:15-16/Acts 17:25)

IV. ENTER INTO TO HIS GATES WITH THANKSGIVING, AND INTO HIS COURTS WITH PRAISE. BE THANKFUL UNTO HIM AND BLESS HIS NAME! (Psalm 100:4)

Two keys that always open the door into God's presence:

#1 – THANKSGIVING

Ps 106:1, 107:1, 118:1, 1 Chron 16:34, Ps 136:3, Ps 118:29, (all say): Oh give thanks to the LORD, for He is good, for his steadfast love endures forever.

#2 - PRAISE

Thanksgiving and Praise go together

SHORT list of Benefits of PRAISE...

- 1. Praise renews your strength (Psalm 103)
- 2. Praise lifts your spirit (Psalm 42:5-6)
- 3. Praise can replace sadness (Isaiah 61:3)
- 4. Praise can open your understanding (Psalm 73:16-17)
- 5. Praise helps us remember God's blessings (Psalm 105)
- 6. Praise enlarges your perception of God (Psalm 69:30)
- 7. Praise and strength are connected (Psalm 8:2/Matthew 21:16)
