FOUR LIFE GIVING WORDS Trust, Delight, Commit, Rest

- I. **TRUST in the LORD** (Psalm 37:3/Ephesians 2:10/James 2:14)
- II. **DELIGHT in the LORD** (Psalm 37:4)
- III. COMMIT your way to the LORD (Psalm 37:5-6)
- IV. REST in the LORD (Matthew 11:28-29/Psalm 37:25/Psalm 37:27-29/ Psalm 37:30-31/Psalm 37:34/Psalm 37:39-40)

KEY: TRUST (not faith) – but faith makes it possible. (Psalm 37:3/Matthew 6:26, 30/John 13:15/Isaiah 26:3/ Proverbs 3:5-6)
