


Love One Another - #5



Part 1 – BAPTISM

BAPTISM: (Greek: *baptizó*) "to dunk, submerge, dip, wash" (Luke 11:37-38/Mark 1: 9–11/Acts 19:1-5/ Acts 8:38/ Acts 16:31/ Rom 10:9/John 1:12/John 20:31)

Baptism: "I am going public. I am identifying this Jesus Christ and His teachings." God doesn't have any grandchildren.

Part 2 – The Six Terms for COMMUNION

COMMUNION: The sacred use of the bread and cup as demonstrated and commanded by Jesus Christ. It is a worshipful thanksgiving to God in which we remember the saving death of Jesus Christ, celebrate his victorious resurrection, hope for his return when he establishes his kingdom and experience His presence with our brothers and sisters in Christ.

1. THE LORD'S TABLE

(1 Cor 10:21/Rom 10:9)

Worship Response: Re-submission to His Lordship

2. THE LORD'S SUPPER

(1 Corinthians 11:20)

Worship Response: Remember... all HE has done. (Meditate/ponder)

3. THE BREAKING OF BREAD

(Luke 24:13-35/Acts 2:42

Worship Response: To celebrate! Jesus is still alive!

4. **COMMUNION**

(1 Corinthians 10:16/Luke 22:20/1 Corinthians 12:12-14, 20/John 17:20-23)

Worship Response: Confession and reconciliation.

5. THE EUCHARIST

(Luke 22:19/Matt 15:36/Matt 26:27-27)

Eucharisto = gratitude/thanks.

Worship Response: Be thankful and hopeful.

6. LOVE FEAST

(Jude 1:12/1 Cor 11:33)

Worship Response: To deeply love our brothers and sisters in Christ.

Therefore...

- 1. Submit to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- 2. Remembering His sacrifice to pay price for our sins.
- 3. Celebrate his resurrection!
- 4. Confess our sins and reconcile with brothers/sisters in Christ.
- 5. Give thanks
- 6. Love each other deeply.
