I. ACT JUSTLY

Be ethical in all you do (Leviticus 24:22/Proverbs 31:9/Zechariah 7:10-11)

II. LOVE MERCY

(Micah 6:8/1 Corinthians 12) **Mercy** – God's unconditional grace and compassion Why MERCY is important to YOU: If you are not a merciful person...

- a. You will be judgmental.
- b. You will become bitter.

III. WALK HUMBLY

(Micah 6:8/Philippians 4:13/Ephesians 2:8-10/ Deuteronomy 8:18)

NOTE: Micah 6:8 is NOT required for salvation

It is an INDICATOR of your walk with the LORD.

- > You cannot **know justice** until you have been justified by the Almighty Judge.
- > You cannot **love mercy** until you have experienced the mercy of God.
- > You cannot walk humbly with your God until you surrender your life to HIM.
