



The Magi: The Star, Their Faith and Gifts Matthew 2

Matthew 2: Written for Jewish audience. They KNEW Old Testament Scriptures/prophecies.

Matthew 2:1 (NAS): "...<u>after</u> Jesus was born in Bethlehem..." Matthew 2:1 (KJV): "...<u>when</u> Jesus was born..."

NKJV-KJV: "wise men" AMP: "magi" – wise men; Passion Version: "spiritual priests" – astrologers

Bethlehem

Hebrew scholars saw this town to be birthplace of the Messiah. (Micah 5:2; John 7:42; Luke 2)

Magi

Philosophers, the counselors of rulers, learned in all the wisdom of the ancient East. The wise men who came seeking the Christ child were <u>not</u> idolaters; they were upright men of integrity.

Two-year Journey – Star in the East – Bethlehem Numbers 24:17; Daniel 9:25,26; Matthew

2:2-6; Micah 5:2; John 7:40-42

Herod – The Scoundrel Matthew 2:8

The Gifts – Gifts Worthy of a King

Matthew 2:10-12 **Gold:** A precious metal and valuable commodity; a symbol of divinity.

Frankincense: A white resin made from tree bark; highly fragrant and often used in worship services and sacrifices in the Old Testament; a sign of holiness and righteousness, and sacrifice.

Myrrh: Another product from trees; a spice used in embalming; occasionally mixed with wine to form a drink like that given to Jesus on the cross as a stupefying potion – sometimes called "gall." Signified suffering, affliction, and bitterness.

The Rest of the Story

Magi – Great Men of FAITH
