GBC Pavilion Project 2026

The GBC elder board is happy to announce an exciting project for 2026. As we seek to develop our property for ministry and outreach in the years ahead, we want to make better use of our outside space.

Towards this end, we were prayerfully led to pursue the building of a permanent pavilion, patio, and fire ring out on our western field. This will allow for future weddings, youth group events, concerts, graduation parties, and other activities to take advantage of the beautiful spot of land God has given us.

This pavilion would be a permanent structure, 40' by 80', with a concrete slab floor, open sides, composite roof, lighting, and sound capabilities. The current tent would be repurposed for other uses in the life of the church (e.g., over our stage for concerts). Construction would begin in the spring of 2026 and would hopefully be completed for summer use.

A number of design options are being considered, including exact location, orientation, landscaping, sidewalks, etc. Issues such as playground location, outdoor concert usage, and an improved campfire site are all factors.

The design team is planning to include:

- 1.) Access via new sidewalks from the parking area, with handicap accessibility.
- 2.) Landscaping (design by Bloomers)
- 3.) An upgraded fire ring and patio area

Funding breakdown:

40' x 80' pavilion	\$104,000
Electrical work	\$25,000
Landscaping, fire ring, sidewalks & extras	\$30,000
10% contingency	\$16,000
Total Project Cost	\$175,000



The most exciting part about this is that a handful of generous donors have dedicated funds that will match our gifts up to \$100,000. Every dollar donated from the church body will thus be doubled!

If we happen to raise more than needed, the excess donated funds will be used for other improvements to the building and grounds, such as playground equipment, outdoor sporting sites, sidewalks to connect us to the neighborhood on the east side, tree planting, etc.

How to Donate

There are four main ways to donate:

- (1) Cash or check, given in our offering boxes (writing "Land Development Fund" on the envelope) or given through the GBC app ("Land Development Fund")
- (2) Directly transferred securities (stocks, bonds, etc., often able to be done without tax penalty)
- (3) Qualified charitable distributions (if 70 1/2 years old, can disburse from retirement accounts, with no income tax)
- (4) An already-established donor advised fund.
