Take it home:

Discuss how faith develops (**Read Luke 17:5-6**)

Application:

The message discussed how Timothy's grandmother, Lois and his mother, Eunice had faith. Paul then stated that this same faith was in Timothy. Three generations of faith are seen. **Discuss how your faith might be passed on to the next generation.**

Discuss how faith can be:

1) Genuine

Read James 1:5

Discuss who is being deceived when one's faith is not genuine?

2) Generating

Read James 2:8

Discuss the evidence of faith should be visible in the life of one who is following Jesus.

3) Generous

Read Galatian 5:22-23 and Philippians 2:3

Discuss ways in which faith can motivate us to place the needs of others above our own.
