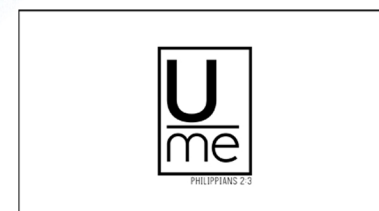
What about you? How has Keystone Church impacted your life? Do you believe in what we see as God's calling for this church?

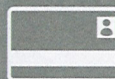
