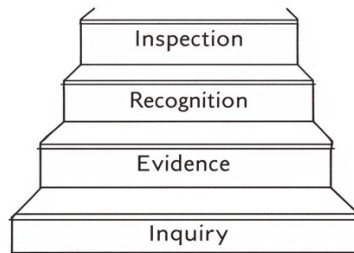


The Staircase of Faith John 20

Recognition (John 20:11-16) – Mary recognized the voice of Jesus when he spoke to her. This converted her perception into conviction.

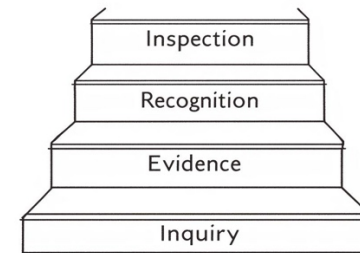
Direct Inspection (John 20:19-27) – Jesus gave the disciples and Thomas the opportunity to inspect his body directly.
