The hero of the story is never strong enough to win on his or her own.

King Solomon's heart is turned away from God to other gods, the gods of his foreign wives and his legacy is lost.

THE DIVIDED KINGDOM

God selected a man named Jeroboam to be King over the northern 10 tribes.

Solomon tried to kill Jeroboam, but Jeroboam fled to Egypt, to Shishak the king, and stayed there until Solomon's death. I Kings 11:40 NIV

THE PAST CAN BRING DIVISION OR UNITY IN THE FUTURE

The kingdom of Israel is split BECAUSE the failed leadership of an unfaithful leader named Solomon.

Our decisions will affect the future. They will lead to either blessings or hardships.

COUNSEL CAN HINDER OR HELP BUILD UNITY
