### **I. THE HEART OF A GODLY HUSBAND (1 Peter 3:7)**

#### **Live with Understanding**

- Love your wife with wisdom and unity
- Apply knowledge with compassion
- Reflect Christ's love in the home

#### **Give Honor**

- Treat your wife as precious
- Never dominate or demean
- Lead with humility and care

#### **Heirs Together**

- Equal in grace
- Equal in salvation
- Equal in eternal standing before God
