#### I. THE RIGHT RESPONSE TO GOD'S LOVING CHASTENING

### Hebrews 12:12-13

- Faith comes by hearing, obeying, and submitting to God's Word.
- Disobedience brings distance, discouragement, and confusion.
- The correct response is:
  - 1. **Lift up your hands** submission, praise, gratitude.
  - 2. Strengthen your knees stop begging for forgiveness already granted; walk in it.
  - 3. Make straight paths remove sin's cause and begin walking by faith.

# Why?

- Without faith in Christ, you remain spiritually lame and broken.
- Others who are broken need to see the healing work of God in you.
