The Corinthian Epistles Chapter 15 Part 1

The Resurrection of Christ

- 1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;
- **2** By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.
- **3** For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;
- **4** And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:
- 5 And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve:
- 6 After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.
- **7** After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles.
- **8** And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.
- **9** For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.
- **10** But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.
- **11** Therefore whether *it* were I or they, so we preach, and so ye believed.
 - As we look at chapter 15 let's settle in our hearts and minds that we are a people with hope.

- Christ is our hope.
- Christ is our resurrection
- Christ is our life
- Paul is dealing with folks who are believing things that are simply not true
- Let's look at truth and embrace it!
- **1** Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;
- **2** By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.
 - We ought to know what the Gospel is
 - Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.
 - **17** For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.
 - If we have been justified by the gospel...
 - We have to trust it no matter what we hear
 - We have to trust it no matter how we feel
 - Living by faith is having confidence in God's person and power regardless of personal perception
 - If you have believed in vain...
 - o This means your belief isn't/wasn't real
 - o You may have had a feeling or strong emotion
 - But faith is not about a feeling or emotion

- Faith is deciding that something is absolutely true regardless of what you see, hear, or feel
- **3** For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;

- **7** After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles.
 - Observational evidence has been professed
 - Jesus did die on the Cross at calvary
 - He did this to be the demanded sacrifice for the sins of God's creation
 - He fulfilled the law
 - He kept God's Word
 - He completed all prophecies foretelling of God's salvation to mankind
 - He was buried in a borrowed grave and stayed there for three days, just as scripture prophesied
 - o He walked out of that very grave as flesh and bone
 - Peter, John, James, Mary, Joanna, and many others witnessed Jesus walking, talking...eating...all the things dead people cannot do
 - o Over 500 people witnessed Jesus' resurrected body
 - Many are still around to testify of these FACTS today (says Paul to the church)
 - Jesus' own half-brother and the pastor of the church at Jerusalem witnessed Jesus Christ resurrected

- These are facts that we today will either accept on faith or reject
 - We don't have people we can go to who physically witnessed the Lord's resurrected body
 - We have God's Word and the word of those servants of God

- Paul says, "oh, by the way, I saw Him too"
 - Christ made a special appearance to me
 - I saw His scars and knew they were for me
- **9** For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.
- **10** But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.
- **11** Therefore whether *it* were I or they, so we preach, and so ye believed.
 - Paul felt unworthy, but believed
 - His faith in a resurrected Christ changed his life completely
 - o He was a pharisee
 - o He was a murderer
 - He was a non-believer
 - o He Is what he is because...
 - Christ's grace
 - It has purpose

- Grace gave Paul purpose
- We can believe or not...it won't change what is truth
 But if we believe the truth, the truth will change us
