Psalm 119

A Verse-by-Verse Study **PE (Mouth, Expression, Vocalization)**

- PE is about our being a vessel of praise to Jehovah
 - o It's derived from a word meaning container (kah)
 - o And Yod or Jehovah
 - So, we are containers of Jehovah that should praise Him vocally

129 Thy testimonies *are* wonderful: therefore doth my soul keep them.

- Walking in what God has done is a way to praise Him
 - o This means that there has to be a walk
 - This means that we believe that all He does in our lives is good...even those things that may not seem good at the present
 - Realizing that God's Works...or grace is good, we don't change them to something that is not grace
 - This means we don't make life about us, but about God

130 The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.

- God's Word is light...
 - Jesus is God's Word...
 - o Jesus is Light!
 - Jesus gives His Spirit
 - o His Spirit leads us to Truth
 - o Jesus is Truth

- His Spirit empowers us to understand the truth
- We then choose to walk in the way of Truth
- o Jesus is the Way...
- o It's all about Jesus!

131 I opened my mouth and panted: for I longed for thy commandments.

- **Psalm 42:1** As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God.
- Matthew 5:6 Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.
- John 4:14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.
- John 6:35 And Jesus said unto them, "I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst."
- John 7:37 "Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink."
- James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all *men* liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- If we want to vocalize our praises of God, we must be filled with God

132 Look thou upon me, and be merciful unto me, as thou usest to do unto those that love thy name.

 We need godly sorrow for sin in our lives and a desire for God to cleanse us

- This only comes when our love for Him is greater than our love for self
 - If we love Him, we will keep His commandment to love Him
 - 1Jon 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
 - 2Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.
- God does love us and desires to cleanse us and use us

133 Order my steps in thy word: and let not any iniquity have dominion over me.

- **Psalm 37:23** The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way.
- **John 16:13** Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that* shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.
 - **14** He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine and shall shew *it* unto you.
- **Romans 8:1** There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- Galatians 5;16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

134 Deliver me from the oppression of man: so will I keep thy precepts.

- Deliverance comes before our obedience
 - Our obedience is a byproduct of being delivered
 - It is only in our delivered state that we will have the power to flee from sin and self
 - 1John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

135 Make thy face to shine upon thy servant; and teach me thy statutes.

- We worship God and Christ from the acceptance we have in Christ
 - Not for acceptance by God and Christ
- We must live in this place of acceptance by fleeing sin and obeying the Word & Spirit

136 Rivers of waters run down mine eyes, because they keep not thy law.

- If sin in your life does not cause you godly sorrow...
 - It will adversely affect your ability to praise God
 - o It will adversely affect your ability to serve God
 - It will adversely affect your desire to praise and serve God
- We must have an abhorrence to sin in our lives
 - And when sin has been allowed in our lives we must allow the Word & Spirit bring that godly sorrow so we might come to Christ from a place of real repentance
