I. SALVATION IS MORE THAN GOING TO HEAVEN

- Salvation includes:
 - **Justification** – one-time act at salvation
 - **Sanctification** – lifelong growth in Christ
 - **Glorification** – freedom from sin’s presence
- Forgiveness through Christ’s **blood**
- New life through Christ’s **resurrection**

II. WHY BE FREE FROM SIN?

- God is holy; sin cannot coexist with Him
- Sin always produces fruit:
 - Shame
 - Separation
 - Death

III. FREEDOM REQUIRES REPENTANCE

- Repentance = turning toward God
- Not outward regret, but inward change
- Confession and forsaking bring mercy

IV. YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN

- Salvation is not:
 - Church attendance
 - Baptism
 - Intellectual belief
- New birth brings:
 - New heart
 - New spirit
 - God's Spirit within

V. BELIEVERS ARE DEAD TO SIN

- Old nature vs. new nature

- Sin remains present, but no longer rules
- Our identity is now **in Christ**

- No neutrality:
 - Servants of sin
 - Servants of righteousness
- True freedom is found in Christ
