Do You Know God's Will? Can You Make Good Decisions?

The Day of the Lord

1Thessalonians 5:1 But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you.

- **2** For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.
- **3** For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.
- **4** But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.
- **5** Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.
- **6** Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.
- **7** For they that sleep, sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night.
- **8** But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.

- **9** For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
- **10** Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him.
- 11 Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.
- End Times purpose for Knowing God's Will
 - o Paul says, "You don't need me to tell you"
 - This implies that we should already know
 - This puts the ownness on us to be aware of the end times and what they look like
 - It's coming when we don't know...we should know that
 - o There will be NO peace and safety until Christ comes
 - We are to walk in the light
 - This means when Jesus comes back...it should not surprise us
 - This should not fill us with fear and dread
 - That is how those in the dark will feel
 - We are not in the Dark...we have the Word!
 - God's Wrath is not for His Children
 - We have been given salvation
 - So, we comfort each other with FACTS

- And we encourage one another to walk in the Light
 - To walk in what we know...what do we know?

God's Known Will

- **12** And we beseech you, brethren, to know them which labor among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you;
- **13** And to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake. And be at peace among yourselves.
- **14** Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all *men*.
- **15** See that none render evil for evil unto any *man*; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all *men*.
- 16 Rejoice evermore.
- 17 Pray without ceasing.
- **18** In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- 19 Quench not the Spirit.

- 20 Despise not prophesyings.
- 21 Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.
- 22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.
- We can get so wrapped in trying to know God's Will
 - as if we are waiting on some special message to just light up in Scripture
 - or some physical sign that would substantiate really what our will is not so much His will.
- God's will is simple...
 - o Not for us to seek for
 - o but something for us to live in.
- Outside of this passage we know from Christ's own mouth,
 - o "If you love Me, keep my commandments".
 - We also know those commandments to be to "Love the LORD your God with all your heart, soul, mind, and might;
 - o then to love your neighbor as yourself".
- These are God's Words revealing His active will.
- Nothing has negated this will for us in any way...
- Nothing we interpret from the Word and
- Nothing anyone might supersede the Word of God, so...

- Rest assured that you have a servant that labors in love for you
- o Take what is said from this position serious
- Let's look how this list of things written to the Thessalonian church are simply how following the commandments looks in our daily life.
 - In Other Words...this is God's Known Will for each of us
- Warn them that are unruly (loving our neighbor)
 - This is striving to reach the lost
 - This is lovingly helping those who are rebelliously ignoring God's Word and Will
- Comfort the feeble minded (loving our neighbor)
 - Not everyone is resting in faith but are wrestling with their faith
 - Some struggle to read and or study God's Word...encourage them and be the Word before them
- Support the weak (loving our neighbor)
 - o This is physical and spiritual

- We tend to judge here instead of coming alongside them and being God's Strength in their life
- Be patient toward ALL men (loving our neighbor)
 - Not everyone will agree with the direction you're going and want to join you
 - Some will aggressively oppose themselves
 - 2Timothy 2:25 In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth;
- Don't be evil to evil given, follow that which is Good (loving our neighbor) This is being like Jesus!
 - Jesus is that which is good...follow Him
 - This is not just something for us to do ourselves,
 - but we are to provoke our brethren to do the same...
 - this means lovingly call them out when we see the need
- Rejoice Evermore!!! (Loving God with all we are)
 - No matter the season or circumstance seek to be filled with the Joy of the Lord

- We know that everything God allows in our life is for His glory and our good...so rejoice
- Pray without Ceasing (loving God and our neighbor)
 - This is having a day long conversation with God...
 - When weakness or sin begins to rob our focus...pray
 - Pray for those who are unruly, weak, feeble minded...they need Jesus just as we do
- IN EVERYTHING give thanks
 - Every situation is an opportunity to learn from and bring glory to God
 - Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.
 - God is not trying to hurt you, He is refining you
 - Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.
- Oh Wait...there's more!
 - Quench not the Spirit...this means...don't stop following Jesus...don't let sin in

- Despise not prophesyings...Don't get mad at truth when it confronts you
 - When the pastor says that the way you're going is a path to pain and destruction...don't get mad
 - When what you believe is confronted by the Word of God...listen, don't get stiff necked
- Prove ALL Things!...be Berean by nature
 - Acts 17:11 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.
 - Make sure you know the Word
 - Try obedience first...prove it works

O Hold Onto what is Good!

- Don't let anyone take from you what God has given you
- This is after you follow 1-3 before this

Abstain from ALL appearance of Evil

 This is the point where we should have some spiritual discernment

- This is where we don't make the choices in our lives, for the choice to obey the Word was already made
- If you have to ask if it's ok, don't do it until you have a godly, biblical answer
- If you had to manipulate scripture to do it...
- But when we allow God's Word to be the authority
- And God's Spirit to be our Guide...
- 23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I* pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 24 Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.
