

THE PURPOSE AND VALUE OF TRIALS FOR BELIEVERS

1 Peter 1:6–17 (KJV)

I. REJOICING IN THE MIDST OF TRIALS (vv. 6–7)

- Trials are **temporary** (“for a season”)
- Trials are **necessary** (“if need be”)
- Trials produce **heaviness**, yet not hopelessness
- Faith is **tried like gold**, but far more valuable

Truth:

God uses trials to **reveal, refine, and prove** our faith

Notes:

II. THE TESTING AND VALUE OF FAITH (v. 7)

- Faith must be **tested to be proven**
- Testing:
 - Reveals **genuineness**
 - Exposes **strength**
 - Produces **purity**
- Gold perishes — **faith endures eternally**

Truth:

Unproven faith is **unreliable faith**

III. LOVING AND TRUSTING AN UNSEEN CHRIST (v. 8)

- We have not seen Him — yet we **love Him**
- We do not see Him — yet we **believe Him**
- This produces:
 - **Joy unspeakable**
 - **Full of glory**

Truth:

Joy is not happiness — it is **deep spiritual peace in Christ**

IV. THE END OF OUR FAITH (v. 9)

- The goal: **salvation of your souls**
- Trials are not the end — they are the **process**
- Faith carries us to **final fulfillment in Christ**

Truth:

What God starts in faith, He **finishes in glory**

V. THE GREATNESS OF OUR SALVATION (vv. 10–12)

- Prophets:
 - **Searched diligently**

- Saw glimpses of Christ's suffering and glory
- Their message was for **future believers**
- Angels:
 - **Desire to look into salvation**
 - Observe God's work in believers

Truth:

We experience what prophets **anticipated** and angels **marvel at**

Notes:

VI. LIVING IN LIGHT OF TRUTH (vv. 13–17)

1. Prepare Your Mind

- “Gird up the loins of your mind”
- Be **intentional in thinking**

2. Be Sober

- Live with **self-control and clarity**

3. Hope Fully in Grace

- Past grace (salvation)
- Present grace (daily living)
- Future grace (Christ's return)

4. Live as Obedient Children

- Reject former lusts
- Walk in **transformed living**

5. Be Holy

- Holiness = **set apart for God**

- “Be ye holy; for I am holy”

6. Walk in Reverence

- God judges **impartially**
- Live with **fear (reverence)** during your sojourning

Truth:

Saved people are called to **separated, serious, surrendered living**
