#### Central Truth

Revival begins when we recognize who God is and respond in broken repentance.

---

#### I. God's OMNIPRESENCE

*You Cannot Flee Him*

(Jonah 2:4–6)

- Jonah tried to run from God's will.
- God met him in the depths.
- There is no place beyond His presence.

#### II. God's OMNISCIENCE

*You Cannot Fool Him*

(Jonah 2:7–8)

- God knew Jonah's heart.
- Ignorance of God's will is often willful.
- Sin causes us to “forsake our own mercy.”

*You Cannot Fight Him*

(Jonah 2:6, 9–10)

- God sent the storm.
- God prepared the fish.
- God commanded deliverance.
- "Salvation is of the LORD."
