

# El Elyon

***18 And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high H5945 God H410.***

***19 And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high H5945 God H410, possessor of heaven and earth:***

***20 And blessed be the most high H5945 God H410, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.***

**H5945 Elyon**; from H5927; an elevation, i.e. (adj.) lofty (comparison); as title, the Supreme:—(Most, on) high(-er, -est), upper(-most).

**H410 El** shortened from H352; strength; as adjective, mighty; especially the Almighty (but used also of any deity):—God (god), × goodly, × great, idol, might(-y one), power, strong. Compare names in '-el.'

### **Describe Sovereign.**

Sovereign god means that God is the supreme ruler of the universe, with complete and ultimate authority, power, and control over all things. This concept signifies that everything that exists and happens is a result of His will, governing all of creation, the laws of nature, and even the actions of humans. It implies that there is no such thing as chance or luck, and that God's control is absolute.

**Supreme authority:**

A sovereign god is the "King of Kings" and has ultimate power and control over everything in heaven and on earth.

**• • Divine will:**

All events occur because God wills it, and everything happens according to His divine will and plan.

**• • Ownership of creation:**

His sovereignty is tied to His ownership of the universe and all within it, making Him the ultimate ruler of all creation.

**• • Absolute control:**

God's sovereignty means He is in complete control, and nothing occurs outside of His decree or allowance.

**• • Governing all things:**

This includes the laws of nature, catastrophic events, and the actions of human beings, as all are governed by His will
