

THE CALL TO HOLY LIVING AND REDEMPTION

1 Peter 1:17–25 (KJV)

I. WALK IN REVERENT FEAR BEFORE GOD (v. 17)

- God is both **Father and Judge**
- His judgment is **impartial**
- Our life is a **temporary sojourning**

Truth:

Reverence for God shapes how we live daily

Notes:

II. REMEMBER THE PRICE OF YOUR REDEMPTION (vv. 18–19)

- Not redeemed with:
 - Silver
 - Gold
- Redeemed with:
 - **The precious blood of Christ**

Key Realities:

- Redemption is **costly**
- Redemption is **personal**
- Redemption frees us from **vain living**

Truth:

You don't belong to yourself — you were **bought with a price**

Notes:

III. KNOW YOUR REDEEMER (vv. 20–21)

- Christ was:
 - **Foreordained before creation**
 - **Manifest in these last times**
 - **Raised and glorified by the Father**
- Through Him:
 - We **believe in God**
 - Our **faith and hope rest in God**

Truth:

Our faith is not in circumstances — it is in a **risen, glorified Christ**

Notes:

IV. LIVE OUT TRUE BROTHERLY LOVE (v. 22)

- Souls purified through:
 - **Obedience to truth**
 - **Work of the Spirit**
- Command:
 - Love one another
 - With a **pure heart**
 - **Fervently**

Truth:

True salvation produces **genuine love for others**

Notes:

V. UNDERSTAND YOUR NEW BIRTH (v. 23)

- Born again:
 - Not of **corruptible seed**
 - But **incorruptible**
- Through:
 - **The Word of God**

Truth:

Your spiritual life comes from something that **never dies**

Notes:

VI. RECOGNIZE WHAT LASTS (vv. 24–25)

- Man:
 - Like **grass**
 - Glory fades quickly
- But:
 - **The Word of the Lord endures forever**

Truth:

Everything fades except **God's Word and what it produces**
