Arm Yourself with Christ's Mind

- Make a decisive break with sin.

Live with Eternity in View

- Holy living is always worth the cost.

The believer's past should never define the believer's future.

- Forgive freely.
- Practice hospitality without complaining.

Serve Faithfully

- Use your spiritual gifts.
- Steward God's grace well.
- Serve in God's strength.

God's grace is not only given to us—it is meant to flow through us.
