"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." - Matthew 28:19-20

What does it mean to "make disciples"?
Mαθητής - (noun)a disciple, a pupil, a "learner"
With implications of being an adherent of the teacher
Mαθητευω - (verb) to be or to make one a disciple
In the current context, this is an imperative/command

- Making disciples is ALWAYS more than evangelism, though it is NEVER less.
 - First a man must be born again, but then he must be instructed in the word of truth.
- An establishment that sacrifices one for the sake of the other IS NOT A CHURCH.

What are the duties of the Church?

The Church of Jesus Christ has been commanded to do three things

- Make Disciples
- Baptize Believers
- Observe the Lord's Supper

What is Baptism?

The outward, post conversion demonstration of an inward reality that has already occurred at conversion.

Baptism not only signifies a turning way form sin but also serves as a public affirmation of one's identification and union with him in his death, burial, and resurrection.

Baptism in the Scriptures

Baptism in the Scriptures

- There is not a single instance in the NT where baptism does not accompany belief and repentance.
- Baptism is ALWAYS in accompaniment with belief/faith.

Baptism and Salvation

If Baptism is always in accompaniment with faith, is baptism necessary for salvation?

Baptism and Salvation

While baptism is closely linked with salvation, it is a human work and therefore is not part of the Gospel. It cannot save you.

Why then should we be baptized?

Why Baptism?

- Baptism is a means by which we **identify** with Christ. It is a statement to the world that you are now a part of something else.
- Baptism preaches the Gospel
 - Death (Christ's/yours to sin)
 - Burial (Proof of death/identify with Christ)
 - Resurrection (To glory/to a life of obedience)

Who Should be Baptized?

Believers in Jesus Christ

- There is not a single instance in Scripture of anyone being baptized that has not already believed and repented. Infant or otherwise.
- Likewise, there's no precedence for an unbaptized believer in the NT through the 2nd Century

Mode of Baptism

- Is there a proper way to Baptize?
 Bourt (u) To pluppe or to dip
- * β απτιζω To plunge or to dip
- Matthew 3:16
- Acts 8:39

Mode of Baptism

It seems that there is no reason to suggest that "to baptize" means anything other than to submerge a person in water and then bring them up out of the water.

This practice was the norm in the early church... until they started baptizing babies.

What is the Lord's Supper?

- Matthew 26:26-30
 Mark 14:22-26
 Luke 22:14-20
- I Corinthians 11:23-34

Four Views

- Transubstantiation The bread and wine are transformed into the actual body and blood of Christ. Consuming the elements fills the partaker with grace.
- Consubstantiation While grace is not infused nor the elements transformed, the actual person of Christ is present around and in the elements.
- Spiritual Presence The presence of Christ is real with his church as they partake of His supper together so that there is real "communion" with Him.
- Memorial The sacrificial death of Christ is remembered by his followers while they also eagerly await the day of His return.

- Anyone who is present?

Who Should Partake?

- You view of the Lord's Supper is going to greatly influence your answer
 - Transubstantiation Anyone
 - Consubstantiation Anyone?
 - Spiritual Presence Believers (+Family?)
